Dear Friends

I am delighted to have been invited to join you today to celebrate all that God is doing at All Saints' and to support Beverly and your PCC in your giving campaign. These are exciting times. The 'Quiet Revival' has brought a new openness to faith and it is wonderful that you have chosen to invest so generously in growth through the Big Build Project.

As Beverly has set out in her letter, the next challenge is to fund the day-to-day ministry of the All Saints' which, in the year ahead, will require a 30% increase in total giving. This may feel like a mightily big step, but we have found in other parishes that this can be achieved if:

- all in the church family commit to giving monthly from bank accounts through the Parish Giving Scheme rather than, for instance, putting money in the plate, so your PCC knows for certain how much will be received in giving and Gift Aid each month
- and all those who already give through bank accounts ask "am I bringing God my 'first fruits' and making my giving to His work my top priority?" and then pray for guidance and the faith to move to a new and, in some cases, substantially higher level of giving.

Moving to a new level of giving may feel daunting but God promises that, if you trust Him by giving sacrificially and cheerfully, "you will be enriched in every way so that you can be generous on every occasion" (2 Corinthians 9:11). Down the ages, Christians have found that we cannot outgive God and, as we experience His faithfulness, we are given the faith to take the next step in our giving. We grow in faith as we grow in giving.

Finally, it will greatly bless your PCC if all those currently giving by standing order could also in future give through the Parish Giving Scheme. This is easy to join online at parishgiving.org.uk, by phone on 0333 002 1271 or by completing and posting the form enclosed with your letter.

Mission Focus for February: Guildford Town Centre Chaplaincy (GTCC)

GTCC is run by various Guildford churches for the people of Guildford. Over 100 volunteers are: Street Angels; Community Angels and Volunteer Chaplains. Since 2008 Street Angels have provided practical care every Friday and Saturday night to people in a vulnerable state in Guildford Town Centre because of eg alcohol, drugs, or homelessness. In 2008, almost overnight, tensions were calmed, crime dropped, and antisocial behaviour was reduced by around a third. More information in February's magazine and on their website gtcc.org.uk/.

A Day of Prayer for Bishop Andrew: Monday 23rd February, 12 noon to 10pm

Join at any stage during the day, for as long as you are able to stay. If you can't attend in person then do join in prayer from home or work. In the Cathedral, there will be opportunity for silent prayer, to pray with others, or to light a candle. Choral Evensong is at 5:30pm, when we will pray in particular for Bishop Andrew and his family. After Evensong, there will be an opportunity, for those who wish, to light a candle and to share in the ministry of laying on of hands and anointing. Teams from each deanery will be present throughout the day to welcome people and to pray with them, and the day will finish with Night Prayer, which will begin at 9:45pm and end at 10:00pm.

Orchard Volunteer Morning: Saturday 28 February, 10.30-1.00pm: We will be working in the compost area and will finish putting fresh compost around the fruit trees, checking bird boxes, weeding around the saplings and raised beds. Meet by the metal shed (bring suitable tools and gardening gloves). We'd greatly appreciate cardboard for the compost heap: plain, uncoated cardboard - plain brown is best – no inks/patterns as these contaminate the soil.

We need to make about a dozen grant applications to different funding bodies in the next three months. You'll be part of a team and with support from Beverly and Trish with making the applications and uploading relevant documents. Please contact Trish if you have a few hours to spare.
