

Role description for Big Build Steering Group members

Role: To be a member of the Steering Group for the 'Big Build' at All Saints, carrying out work within the agreed remit of the Group.

Role Requirements:

To be:

To be a person of integrity, called by God and approved by All Saints church, who serves in a gracious, Christ-like manner; and who treats each member of the Vision Group with respect and dignity, as a unique individual created in the image of God.

To do:

- a) To attend Steering Group meetings whenever possible (usually once a month)
- b) To contribute to discussions, seeking wisdom from God, within the remit of the group
- c) To contribute to proposals which will be presented to the PCC for consideration
- d) To carry out work entrusted to the Steering Group within the agreed remit of its area of responsibility
- e) To attend Services at All Saints regularly (at least fortnightly), in order to have a good understanding of the life of the church
- f) To attend Steering Group meetings regularly, for support and supervision by the Steering Group Chair
- g) To respect the role of the Incumbent, as spiritual leader of the church; and the PCC as the appointed governing body
