Role: To champion those with hearing/sensory loss, and to support them in their needs in practical ways

Role Requirements:

To be:

To be a person who serves in a gracious, Christ-like manner; and who treats each person with respect and dignity, as a unique individual created in the image of God.

To do:

To be trained in the basic maintenance of hearing aids, and checking the hearing aid is working:

This will include: Replacing the battery, battery life; Re-tubing; Fitting the hearing aid in the ear; Hearing aid controls; T-loop; Use of hearing aid; Assistive listening device; Communication tactics; Outline of audiology pathways in your area

- To offer simple maintenance sessions at church events, and in the wider community
- To maintain confidentiality and act with discretion
- To attend one Pastoral Team meeting each year, for support and supervision by the Incumbent
- To read, adhere to and promote all aspects of the All Saints Safeguarding Policy (<u>www.cofeguildford.org.uk/safeguardingpolicy</u>), including recruitment and training requirements; and all other Policies of All Saints Church.

Reports to: The Incumbent/or by delegation to a trained Pastoral Assistant (Chair of the Pastoral Care Vision Group)
